Re: Report on Number of Majors

I am pleased to report that, according to today's EagleData reports, the current total number of declared Economics majors, including double majors, is 100. Last spring at this time we had 81 majors; in Spring 2005 there were 57 declared majors.

Forty percent of our majors are pursuing the BS degree. Few of the double majors choose the BS over the BA. Double majors are about equally split between the General and International tracks.

Additionally, there are 32 intended majors on record. This is down slightly from last year, but may reflect the fact that many sophomores have already declared.

There are 41 minors; last year at this time there were 38.

Economics is holding steady relative to other CAS degree-seekers; we have been between six and eight percent the past three years.
